

Excellence in Neural Engineering Travel Award

Purpose: The goal of the award is to encourage and reward excellence in the field of Neural Engineering. The special emphasis will be on innovative integration between engineering and neuroscience. The award will cover travel expenses of winners for up to \$750. The awards will be made by the members of the organizing committee of the Neural Engineering track.

Eligibility: Graduate students, research associates and assistant professors from US institutions are eligible for the travel award. The abstract must be accepted in the Neural Engineering track and presented at the conference.

Conditions: Submit the following information before February 15th 2009

- 1) Copy of extended abstract submitted to the conference.
- 2) For graduate students and research associate: Letter from faculty advisor stating role of the student and the particular innovative aspect in the neural engineering project
- 3) For assistant professors: Letter signed by the chair of the department stating the innovative aspect of work presented.
